

Hints for the welfare of your birds

When establishing your new birds, some points will be of assistance: -



Do not let your birds out in the dark, but allow maximum day light hours for them to find out their new surroundings.

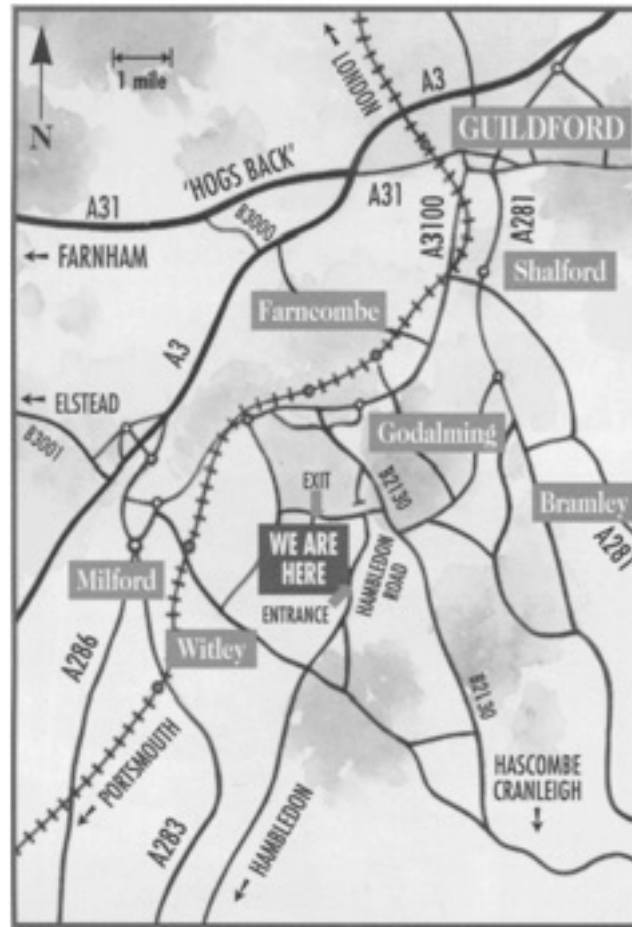
Have a regular food point and feed once or twice a day on a mixture of wheat and Duck/Poultry Maintenance Grower/Breeder pellet. Some species i.e. Mergansers, Goldeneye and Stiffetails etc an addition of Sea Duck floating pellet is recommended. Birds can be Hopper fed, but will need to be introduced to the method.



Predators are the main cause of death. Ideally your enclosure should be FOX PROOF. Please enquire for detailed information on the construction of fences. Rats and Mink need to be controlled at all times. Worming is recommended once or twice a year according to your infestation.

Do fence me in

"FENCING is extremely important," maintains Fleur, "and likely to be your biggest expense. Unless you fence your garden or the enclosure in which you plan to keep your geese, the birds will either get out and wander off or be killed by a fox or dog. Some people seriously expect to be able to leave geese in an unfenced field with a hole in the ground for a pond!

"Leaving geese unfenced is not only unfair on them but means you are virtually throwing away money, for at some point those geese will be killed or become lost and you will have to buy some more."

Chicken wire

FENCING, which can be made of either chicken or rabbit wire, should have a height of at least 1.8m

(6ft) - Fleur's fencing is 2.4m (8ft) high. It should have a floppy overhang to prevent foxes from getting over the top, and extend to at least 46cm (18in) below ground.

"For added security you could also consider putting up a single strand of electrified wiring, but this is not really necessary if the fencing is tall enough and extends far enough beneath the surface," she added.
